

# Welsh Netball Umpire Assessor Pathway

## Prerequisites

- Affiliated to Welsh Netball
- Netball Europe B Award Umpire

## Book on a Welsh Netball Umpire Assessor Course

- The Course will be a 6 hour course with a combination of tutor led presentations and activities plus an on-court assessment, led by a Welsh Netball appointed Tutor.
- All participants will receive a Welsh Netball Assessor Course Resource and Netball Europe Assessor Handbook.

Complete a minimum of two C Award assessments as a trainee assessor under the supervision of a Welsh Netball Licencee assessor.

- Assessment 1 and 2 – Shadow an assessor, complete a Netball Europe Learner Assessment Report Form (LARF) and attend the feedback as a silent observer. Licencee assessor to sign the assessment log book.

Submit your 2 completed Learner Assessment Report Forms (LARFs) plus your signed log book to Welsh Netball. Welsh Netball confirm appointment as a Welsh Netball Licenced C Award

## Post-Licence Assessor Requirements and Pathway

To remain as a C Award Licenced Assessor, complete at least one assessment every calendar year, maintain an assessment log book and attend a Welsh Netball Licence reaccreditation course every three years

To progress to become a B Award Licenced Assessor, complete 2 years as a C Award assessor. Contact Welsh Netball who will arrange 2 shadow B Award assessments. Licencee assessor to sign the assessment log book. Submit your 2 completed Learner Assessment Forms plus your signed log book to Welsh Netball. Welsh Netball confirm appointment as a Welsh Netball Licenced B Award Assessor. Attend a Welsh Netball Licence reaccreditation course every three years
